

LAKELAND ARTS & CRAFTS Banish November greys with cosy fires and Victorian elegance.



**Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup> NOVEMBER:** transfer from Oxenholm station to link with Euston train\* to the LANGDALE CHASE HOTEL. Check in, drinks and canapés before 3 course dinner followed by Bridge for anyone who wishes to

dinner, followed by Bridge for anyone who wishes to play.

Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup>: departing after breakfast we transfer (approx. 15 mins) to Blackwood House, a Grade 1, Arts & Crafts gem. This perfectly preserved snapshot of early 20th-century living has most of its original features, immaculate furniture and beautiful

decorative flourishes. Moving on we call at the awardwinning Lake Windermere Jetty Museum, dedicated to the rich history of the Lake, its boats and people, including Arthur Ransom's famous boats such as Cpt. Flint's Houseboat. After a bite in the Museum's café we return to the Langdale Chase for a walk, read a book, or bridge before a three course dinner.

Thursday 21<sup>st</sup>: after breakfast we drive west (35 mins) to visit the home of the famous writer, artist and social reformer John Ruskin - Brantwood House. Perched above Coniston Water, the 250-acre estate has eight unique gardens created by Ruskin, and was once a vibrant centre of art. Next we have time to explore the tiny town of Hawkeshead before a







delicious lunch at the Drunken Duck Inn. Smart yet relaxed, this famous pub offers a

real sense of place. Food is bold, uses local ingredients and the bar, with own-brew beers, is still a locals' favourite. After lunch we return to the roaring fires at the Langdale Chase, to walk by the lake, read a book by the fire, or play bridge for those who wish. Pre-dinner drink, canapés and three course dinner at the Langdale Chase Hotel.

Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> NOVEMBER; after breakfast, transfer to Oxenholm Railway Station for return train\* to Euston, London.



**LANGDALE CHASE HOTEL:** built in the late 19<sup>th</sup> century this grand Victorian building has been stylishly refurbished. All turrets, stained glass and balustrades, the hotel sits on the shore of Lake Windermere, windows are angled to catch superb views of the fells, lawns sweep down to the lake. Log fires crackle, bedrooms, some with lake views have all been given a contemporary upgrade. The hotel is one of the traditional, famous grand hotels of the Lake District. *"This classy Victorian villa was turned into a hotel in the 1930s and quickly became the place to stay in the Lakes. After a year-long renovation, the grade II listed landmark is back to its maximalist best"* The Times Review.
