Wednesday 2nd – 8th JUNE 2027

 through mountain passes, as the
 ever-changing scenery unfolds,
 We pass glaciers, waterfalls, forests
 and snow-capped peaks and with
 uninterrupted views, we will simply sit
 back and revel in the luxury of **GOLD LEAF SERVICE**
 as the mountain drama unfolds.



Wednesday 2nd JUNE 2027. BANFF: After arrival into **Calgary**, our holiday begins in **BANFF** the gateway to the **ROCKIES**. Surrounded by majestic mountains and situated inside the **National Park**, **Banff** is renowned for its dramatic setting, wildlife and pure fresh air. Arrival private transfer to the **Rimrock, Emblems Collection Hotel: 2 nights**. See below for hotel information. Dinner.

Thurs. 3rd June. BANFF: a morning tour shows off the wonderful setting of the town, with a spectacular ride on the **Gondola** providing us with superb views of six mountain ranges. Within the **National Park** we see **Bow Falls**, and visit the huge, glacial lake of **Minnewanka**, known locally as the **Lake of Spirits**. Afternoon at leisure before we meet for dinner in Banff. B&D



Fri. 4th June: BANFF to JASPER: Sunwapta Valley & Colombia Glacier. Today we delve further into the wild mountain scenery of the **Rockies**, travelling through the two **National Parks** of **Banff** and **Jasper**. In **Sunwapta Valley**, famous for its fossils, waterfalls and wildlife, we experience the vast **COLOMBIA GLACIER**, the largest non-polar icefield in North America which feeds several glaciers. Surrounded by spectacular mountain scenery, we can walk on ancient ice and experience the glass walkway high above the valley floor. There will be time for coffee, lunch and tea breaks during the day before we arrive the **Fairmont Jasper Park Lodge**. (2 nights). BL&D



Sat. 5th June: JASPER NATIONAL PARK & MALIGNE LAKE CRUISE. Today we tour **Athabasca Valley** in Canada's largest national park. After breathtaking views of the massive walls and crashing waterfalls of **Maligne Canyon**, we continue to **Maligne Lake** and change our mode of transport for a **lake cruise**. Dense forests line the shore, whilst glacial peaks rise abruptly from the water's edge. A sumptuous picnic, with wine, sustains us and we have an opportunity to go ashore near Spirit Island. BL&D



Sun. 6th June: ROCKY MOUNTAINEER TRAIN, Jasper to Kamloops.



Early this morning we board our specially-designed, glass-domed train, the **ROCKY MOUNTAINEER**. Travelling **GOLDLEAF class** is a splendid experience in itself (see below) while the glamorous train slices through the heart of British Columbia. Dramatic scenery including the Fraser River valley and **Continental Divide** tower around us. Using the beautiful river valleys of the **Monashee** and **Cariboo Mountains**, our train snakes through the mountains to climb over **Yellowhead Pass**. From the **outdoor viewing platform** we can see the dramatic **Pyramid Falls**, and **Mount Robson**, the highest peak in the Canadian Rockies at 12,972 feet. Approaching **Kamloops**, the track winds beside the **North Thompson River**. Tonight we stay in **Kamloops**, the perfect spot to break our train journey with over 2,000 hours of sunshine per annum. Our hotel will be assigned closer to the date and luggage will be transferred. B&L



Mon. 7th June: ROCKY MOUNTAINEER TRAIN: Kamloops to Vancouver: returning to our indulgent **GOLD LEAF** area of the train, we head west towards the Pacific and the coastal city of **Vancouver** as the scenery varies between lush fields, a desert-like environment, winding river canyons and pristine forests. We pass through **Ashcroft**, one of Canada's driest towns, see the striped cliffs of **Rainbow Canyon**, a riot of pink, green and grey and pass the rushing waters of **Hell's Gate** in **Fraser Canyon**. Our rail varied journey ends in the late afternoon at **Vancouver**. Transfer to the **Fairmont Hotel, Vancouver**: 1 night. (B&L)

Tues. 8th June: Either transfer to the airport or stay on – please enquire. (B)
